Maps are delivered to competitors - 45...60s



2nd line











## Change-Over

- Change-over by a CLEAR CONTACT to starters shoulder (*like in x-country skiing*)
- Starter picks up the map with the team's number
- AT CHANGEOVER
  - Change-over
  - Rapidly to EMIT CONTROL (NOTICE! 20 teams, 6-8 min per leg)
  - (Via service area) Back to Change-over













## GPS, EmiTag and TV

- All competitors have GPS device
  - Installed to number vest 15 min before start
- 2 emiTags
  - Both to same hand
  - 10xx is primary and "Yellow" is back-up
  - In Finish only the primary Tag will be red
- There is some TV crew in the forest
  - Will follow athletes with head cam between some controls












## Weather forecast (27.11. 17:00)
